Cable Wakeboard – ECWC Annual Report 13.01.2021

2020 was certainly an extraordinary year, although there were challenges, we are delighted to report that the Cable Wakeboard community adapted the best way they could, and it meant we were still able to relevant to athletes within the year.

The loss of International events was felt by all, many organiser tried to hold events, but had them cancelled at the last moments, travel restrictions meant that we had to cancel all physical International competitions but we adapted by introducing online virtual competitions. National Federations really stepped up, and where local restrictions allowed, countries ran their Championships, where physical championships couldn't be held, the Federations also adopted the virtual approach.

Our Online International series was well received by our athletes, across the 6 competitions we had 119 unique rider entries (262 Entries) from 24 different countries. All 5 Confederations were represented – this was amazing, the competitions gave us amazing footage, and a much greater social media presence than we had previously. We are looking to continue the Virtual series at least until we are happy to re-open the International physical competition circuit.

UTS Virtual Youth Festival

We had 9 Cable Wakeboard athletes take place in the United Through Sports (UTS) Virtual Youth Festival, this has involved our athletes taking part in Max Fit exercises against athletes from other sports. The participants had to film all 4 rounds (Prelims, Qtr finals, semi Final and Final Rounds), all with 3 different exercises, which were timed depending on their ages dictated how long there round was. This is the first event like this, and there are over 90 Federations involved in the Festival.

3 of our athletes made the Podiums in their age categories, so again, huge congratulations go out to:

Callum Smith – GBR – U16 Max Fit – 3rd Place – Bronze Medal Alessia Klingenbrun – GER – U14 Max Fit – 2nd Place – Silver Medal Kieran Smith – GBR – U14 Max Fit – 2nd Place – Silver Medal

Once we have received the medals from the UTS, we will be arranging an IWWF Medal Ceremony so we can celebrate their achievements properly.

Riders of the Decade:

There was only really two riders we could possibly nominate for this accolade, Both have dominated Cable Wakeboarding in the last decade, and have shown up and supported our sport at every opportunity.

Our riders of the decade were decided as Julia Rick and Lior Sofer, as they have both won 3 World Championships through 2012 – 2020, and have entered all 5 World Championships held during this time. This is there history during 2010-2019
